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- **2.** Is representing video via text (by captioning) sufficient? Are there any scenarios where this wouldn't work well?
- **3.** Are there any better ways to bridge the modality gap between video and text rather than mapping video into text and feeding it into for an LLM?
- **4.** Is the answer to most multi-modal understanding problems just to "throw it into an LLM" at this point?
- **5.** What are the advantages and disadvantages of using LLMs for video QA/dialoging?
- **6.** Is this a good paper?
- 7. Does video understanding necessarily have to involve language modality?
- **8.** Would the proposed approach work on long videos?
- **9.** Are LLMs going to take over computer vision like they did NLP? If so, how should academic researchers co-exist with companies like OpenAI?
